5 Instant retail payments in euro

In its November 2015 meeting the ERPB invited the EPC to address outstanding issues related to key aspects of the scheme (e.g. parameters such as the processing time and amount limits) and to present an interim report at the June 2016 ERPB meeting. The EPC consulted the High-level Group on instant payments reflecting the composition of the ERPB during the process of addressing these outstanding issues. On 12 April 2016, the EPC launched a public consultation on the draft SCT Inst Rulebook. The EPC prepared an interim report to the ERPB to inform on the progress made and the envisaged way forward.

7 Pan-European integration of payment initiation services

As part of the preliminary exchange of views on the update of the ERPB workplan during the November 2015 meeting, concerns were raised that the new "payment initiation services" will be introduced by payment service providers in a non-interoperable/non-standardised way. The Secretariat prepared a note that includes an assessment of these concerns and suggested proposal for follow-up to ensure the successful deployment of payment initiation services at a pan-European level. The ERPB is invited to discuss the Secretariat note and agree on the way forward.
